### PICTURE OF A LIFE SAVED

A woman came in with her elderly mother and a beautiful 2 year old girl. I had not seen this child since shortly after she was born and she came and hugged me and looked up at me with a huge smile. The grandmother leaned toward me and whispered, with tears in her eyes, "You saved this baby- you know that don't you?" Wow, how amazing and humbling

it was to look at this precious, smiling little girl, while recalling the first meeting I had with her mother on December 6, 2011 where she told me that she has an abortion appointment at Planned Parenthood and nothing I could say could change her mind because "it is just the size of a grain of sand". She was angry that her mother talked her in to coming in, and she was very argumentative. After convincing her to go to an ultrasound, and after many counseling sessions, she chose life. Another employee and I worked extensively with her throughout her pregnancy and she attended Parenting Classes, Counseling, and Childbirth Classes regularly. It is truly a miracle to see how well this child is doing after almost not having the opportunity to have a life. The mom says now that she could not imagine her life without this little girl. All glory to God for saving the life of this beautiful little girl. God is a God who performs miracles, and it is He who touches the hearts of the women who change their minds and choose life. It is a privilege and honor that He allows us to be able to be used by Him. The picture of this little girl and her smile as she hugged me will forever be in my mind as a Baby Saved, and I praise Him for this life as well as other children who were almost aborted. The image of her is a reminder that this work is not in vain and it serves as an encouragement to not give up even when the outcome is not what we would hope. ### BY THE NUMBERS 2013

Last year, the CPC had 526 new intakes for clients, performed 236 pregnancy tests, counseled 162 people, had 254 people in parenting and childbirth classes, saw 2,739 visits to Material Support and 1,339 visits to Children's Place! We talked to 50 abortion minded clients, and we know of at least 9 babies who are still alive because their mommies came and talked to us, saw the resources we provide, and chose to continue their pregnancies.

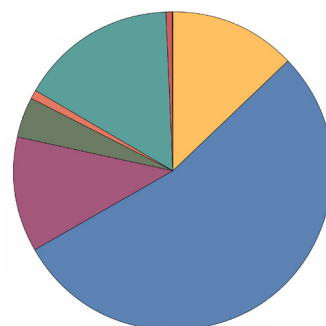

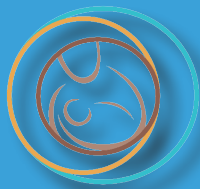

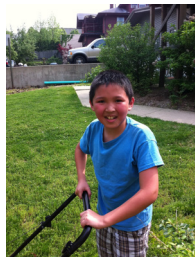
